



# A tax credit for Washington workers!

The Working Families Tax Credit will provide payments up to \$1,255 for tax year 2023 to individuals and families who meet the requirements.

## Who is eligible for the tax credit?

Individuals and families are eligible if they meet all of the following requirements:

- Lived in Washington a minimum of 183 days.
- Are at least 25 and under 65 years of age OR have a qualifying child in 2023.
- Filed a 2023 federal tax return with a Social Security Number (SSN) or an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).
- Eligible for the federal Earned Income Tax Credit on their 2023 tax return.

- Meet the income requirements (see table).

## How much will individuals and families get back?

It depends on the number of qualifying children and income level. See table for estimates based on the 2023 income eligibility thresholds.

## What are the income thresholds?

Number of qualifying children	Applicant must make less than the following		Maximum refund
	Single	Married (filing jointly)	
0	\$17,640	\$24,210	\$315
1	\$46,560	\$53,120	\$625
2	\$52,918	\$59,478	\$940
3 or more	\$56,838	\$63,398	\$1,255
