# WFTC Program Results

Applications refunded by 04/07/2025

67,500 more refunds compared to this time last year!

Total CY25 applications received	264,000
TY24 applications refunded	161,500
TY23 applications refunded	5,000
TY22 applications refunded	2,400
Total CY25 dollars refunded	\$128,869,000
TY24 dollars refunded	\$123,564,000
TY23 dollars refunded	\$3,635,000
TY22 dollars refunded	\$1,670,000
Children impacted	237,000+
